JANUARY 2026

Thu 1st: Pray for Ukraine as they face another year of continuing war. Pray especially for the children, and for those who have a Tumi Tiger, that they will come to know the only One who can truly save and help them.

Fri 2nd: The Urbana conference for young people started on 28th December. Pray that those who attended will not forget what they heard about GRN. Pray also that people will come forward to work with GRN USA in the future as partners or staff.

Sat 3rd: Christine Platt, the Australian Director, and a colleague recently visited a sensitive country with many languages and few Christians, where it has been difficult for GRN to record. Pray for the partnerships they are building with Bible translators and for the recordings of Bible stories and Bible translations they are beginning.

Sun 4th: Praise God for the Bible translators who partner with us and make their Bible translations available on 5Fish so they can be accessed by everyone. Pray that many will come to a saving faith in Christ and learn how to follow Him through these recordings.

Mon 5th: Sanjay and Mary will be busy this year with both their church and GRN. Pray that they will be filled with and guided by the Holy Spirit as they seek to do the Lord's will.

Tue 6th: Pray for Joel, Judith, Daniel, and Joy as they seek to develop opportunities for GRN work in Spain.

Wed 7th: Pray for Sam and his family. He hopes this year to spend time developing the work in Germany, a country with many migrants and refugees, and Christians who are working to help them and show them the Saviour's love.

Thu 8th: Pray for Walter, James, and Monica, who work with GRN in Kenya. Pray for wisdom and the Lord's guidance as they make plans for recording and distribution in the coming year.

Fri 9th: The GRN team in Nigeria works in a volatile and often violent area. They need a new van to provide transport for recording and distribution trips. Pray that the Lord will provide the funds for this need.

Sat 10th: Pray for Graydon, Tim, Sanjay, and Surendra as they seek partners to record in India, a country with many minority languages.

Sun 11th: We thank God for MegaVoice, Kulumi, Galcom, Renew World Outreach, and other organisations that produce solar-powered MP3 players which can be used without electricity or internet. Pray that these devices will go where they are needed and help make disciples of all nations.

Mon 12th: Europe currently has no recording team. Pray that the Lord will call people to this vital task. God is bringing many people from countries closed to the Gospel into Europe. We need to be able to make recordings both for those living in Europe and for those in their home countries who would otherwise never hear.

Tue 13th: We praise the Lord for new centre leaders in the UK, Switzerland, and the USA. Pray that the Lord will call people of His choosing to lead in South Korea, Germany, and Belgium.

Wed 14th: Pray for Sam and Mary and their family, that the Lord will bless them and give Sam the vision and energy he needs for his work with GRN.

Thu 15th: Pray for Marian and the team in the Netherlands as they plan new recordings for 2026.

Fri 16th: In our word-rich society, we often forget that oral learners make up the majority of the world's population. Pray that the recordings available on 5Fish will reach many who would not otherwise hear of their Saviour and bring them to saving faith.

Sat 17th: Internet security is vital to our work. Pray that the Lord will protect our online distribution networks from bad actors and bless the team in Australia who work hard to keep them secure.

OVER 6,500 LANGUAGES RECORDED

Sun 18th: We praise the Lord that we now have recordings available in 6,700 languages and dialects. Pray for the ongoing task of recording languages that are still unreached.

Mon 19th: Linda is now working part-time with GRN. One of her tasks is loading Kulumis with the required languages. Pray for her, and that the players she sends out will reach the right people and be used where God intends.

Tue 20th: Pray for Paule, that she will have opportunities to speak about the work of GRN and make it better known in Switzerland.

Wed 21st: Pray that those working with refugees in Europe will catch the vision for using our materials to reach out to their new neighbours, and that many will respond positively to the message of God's love and saving power.

Thu 22nd: Pray that the Lord will protect our staff who are working in countries where governments are hostile to Christians.

Fri 23rd: Pray for Sanjay and Mary, that the Lord will bless them, draw them closer to Him, and guide their decisions and actions.

Sat 24th: Pray for our new Ambassadors, that the Lord will bless them and give them opportunities to tell others about GRN.

Sun 25th: Praise the Lord for our partners in India who have recorded six out of eight Look, Listen and Live scripts in Kumbhar. Pray that they will be able to record the remaining two this year. Pray also for Brad in Australia as he programmes the recordings they have made.

Mon 26th: Pray for wisdom, protection, and perseverance when recording new languages, especially where access, security, or cultural barriers make work challenging.

How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? 15 And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!" Romans 10:14-15



Tue 27th: Pray for the Thai team as they seek people to help evaluate recordings in the Kayah region to determine if they are suitable for distribution. Some recordings were made years ago and need to be reviewed.

Wed 28th: Prayer warriors are essential if the work of GRN is to be effective in reaching dark places. Pray that we will be able to recruit people who are prepared to stand with us in prayer against spiritual darkness.

Thu 29th: Pray for Bryan Wilson and the team in the USA. They thank God for a new staff member but still have a great need for labourers to work with them in bringing in the Lord's harvest.

Fri 30th: Pray for Pierre and Michou in Belgium as they seek to support, both practically and in prayer, the church in Ukraine that they have partnered with for many years.

Sat 31st: Papua New Guinea has 840 living languages, making it the most linguistically diverse country in the world. Pray for people there and in Australia who are working to overcome obstacles and enable further recording.
