Saturday 1st Sam will be at the New Horizons conference this week with a stand in the exhibition and a place in a seminar. Pray that he will meet people who can use our materials and those who will support us through prayer and other ways.

Sunday 2nd Sam and his family are very thankful for Flavie's near-miraculous recovery from a horrific accident. Pray that Flavie will make good progress through rehabilitation and that the whole family will know the Lord's protection and blessing.

Monday 3rd Jeremie and his wife is still in Burkina Faso. Christian work there has been difficult in recent years because of Jihadist activity. They are aiming to distribute 10,500 Kulumis. Pray they will bear much fruit, that their journey will be safe, and that the Lord will give them wisdom and discernment about the future of GRN in that country.

Tuesday 4th Over the summer, there will be Bible camps for children, teenagers and war widows in Ukraine using GRN equipment and materials. Pray that many will accept Jesus and that others will be strengthened in their faith through these camps.

Wednesday 5th Pray that the 200 Kulumi players will reach the pastor in Bhutan safely and will be used to tell many of their Saviour.

Thursday 6th Sanjay is meeting with the chaplain from Winchester prison. Pray that this will be fruitful and that he will catch the vision for using players to reach prisoners in their mother tongues.

Friday 7th GRN Netherlands asks for prayer for Peter Jan, who is taking Kulumis into Papua and hoping to do some recording there with colleagues from Indonesia.

Saturday 8th Pray for David and Stephen in Myanmar, who are confined to working from home as their country remains a war zone. Pray for their safety and that of their families. Pray also for the work they are doing, assisting Dalene in processing Bible recordings made in South Africa.

Sunday 9th We are thankful for Dalene's leadership of GRN's work in southern Africa. Pray for her protection and wisdom, and for her husband Johan as he faces a number of health challenges.

Monday 10th Alfred and the German team ask for prayer for their project to record the Tamil script in German. They are also sending Kulumis to Kazakhstan. Pray they will arrive safely and bear much fruit.

Tuesday 11th Pray for the team in South Africa who are recording a newly developed "covenant and sacrifice" script, and for Jacobus and Kathleen as they work on trauma scripts.

Wednesday 12th Pray for Walter and James in Kenya as they carry out their planned recordings and distributions.

Thursday 13th Pray for the studio building project in Australia. Pray it will go smoothly and that the new studios will be used to record many gospel messages.

Friday 14th Pray for Bryan and the team in the US. They are still seeking new workers to help make GRN and its materials better known in the country where GRN began.

Saturday 15th Pray for Tim Strauss, International Director, for safe travel and wisdom as he encourages GRN staff across the world. Pray also for his wife Lois, who sometimes travels with him. **Sunday 16th** We thank the Lord for His continuing financial provision for GRN's work in the UK and elsewhere.

Monday 17th GRN Belgium is looking for French-speaking successors to take over from Pierre and Michou, who are stepping down for health reasons. Pray for the conversations they and Sam will be having with two people who have expressed interest.

Tuesday 18th GRN Belgium asks for prayer for the Lord's protection over their long-term collaborators in Ukraine during this time of such widespread destruction.

Wednesday 19th Pray for Sanjay and Mary. Pray for their health, for wisdom as they manage their many priorities, and for a close walk with their Lord and Saviour.

Thursday 20th Pray for Linda and her work loading Kulumis with the required languages, local promotion, and encouraging GRN Ambassadors.

Friday 21st Christians and minority groups are facing persecution in Bangladesh. Pray for our team there as they seek to improve their recording skills.

Saturday 22nd The deaf community are often neglected by society and by the church. Pray for the work being done with them using GRN materials in Pakistan and Ukraine. Pray also for plans for sign language DVDs in other languages.

Sunday 23rd Praise the Lord. Listeners and followers of our materials on YouTube have increased by 25% already this year. Pray that those who find their language this way will listen with open hearts to the gospel message.
Monday 24th South Korea is mission-minded, but GRN currently has no presence there. Pray the Lord will call the right person to lead the work.

Tuesday 25th Choosing the right, culturally appropriate material to record is vital. Pray for wisdom for recording teams across the world as they make these important decisions.

Wednesday 26th Pray for the work being done with partners in India to record the many unrecorded languages across the sub-continent. Pray for wisdom for Graydon, Sanjay and Surrendra as they seek to guide this work from a distance.

Thursday 27th Pray for Christine Platt and the staff of GRN Australia, who bear responsibility for work in many GRN centres while running the office in Australia, which includes teams essential to GRN's work worldwide.

Friday 28th GRN Philippines have created Sunday School materials and trained teachers in using them. Pray these materials will be well used and will benefit the children.

Saturday 29th Sam, Jeremie, Pierre, Michou and Philippe will all be at the AMEN conference in France this weekend. Pray it will be very productive and that useful contacts will be made.

Sunday 30th We thank the Lord for the faithful prayer warriors who support GRN's work. Pray we will find more people to take up this challenge.

Monday 31st Pray for Graydon and the script committee as they seek new scripts and verify that those submitted are theologically and culturally sound.
